A CiT's Day at Hawkeye

A typical day spent in camp begins with a 7:30am wake up. Breakfast is served, with setters from the day's assigned cabin, at 8:00, and followed by a period of cabin clean up. CiT's come to the Dining Hall early to set up all hot drinks (coffee, tea & hot chocolate). In addition 1/3 of CiT's are assigned to oversee cleaning the dishes each meal. The CiT cabin will be a part of cabin inspection so the other CiT's make sure everything gets tidy.

Four days a week the CiT group begins the day in a fun camper type activity such as archery or woodworking. This schedule does not apply for days when the group is on an out-of-camp trip or for special activity days including bunk and tribe days. The second morning period is a Choice period, offerings for which change each day providing a variety of experiences for each CiT.

The last period before lunch can be either a second CiT group activity or a CiT Workshop. Workshops include things like resume creation, interviewing skills, and counseling 101. Instructional swim is a mandatory activity for campers and CiT's alike. It is programmed into the camper choice periods. Each camper choice period has one swimming group scheduled at the waterfront for lessons or a challenge swim.

After lunch, there is an hour and ten minute reading period where CiT's have the opportunity to write letters, read, relax, and just hang out. This quiet time is followed by a second choice period (Arts & Crafts?) and then CiT Apprenticeships which CiT's choose with the help of the CiT Coordinator. After which there is an all-camp free swim or field activity. Dinner is served at 6:00pm.

In the evening, community activities include campfires, all-play field activities, special activities and creative performances. Campers return to their bunks between 8:30 and 8:45 for cabin time, until lights out at 9:00 while CiT's stay up and out of their cabins an extra 1/2 hour with their nightly meeting to process the day. CiT's head back to the cabins at 9:30.
