This is particularly important if you need camp transportation or a pickup from an area airport, train or bus station.

Camp transportation is arranged as early as possible before the opening of camp and most of the time there is no cost for staff. We are willing and able to do pick-ups from area airports including Manchester, NH, and Boston Logan, MA,. In addition there is a train an hour from camp in Concord, NH, and a bus station less than ten minutes away. See the reverse side of this form for driving directions:

Camp Hawkeye

Driving Directions

Boston: 115 miles – 2 Hours 10 minutes (according to Google Maps)

From Boston you are looking at nearly a straight shot North.

- Take 93 North from Boston and follow for 97.4 miles to exit 23 in New Hampshire

Off of the Highway (From Route 93)

- Take Exit 23 “New Hampton/Meredith” (Rte. 132/Rte. 104)
- Turn Right at bottom of the exit ramp and follow for 8.3 miles along Rte. 104
- You will intersect Route 3 at a traffic light above Center Harbor; turn left on Rte. 3
- Follow Rte. 3 into Center Harbor and turn right at main traffic light on 3 which becomes Rte. 25
- Follow Rte. 25 for 6.6 miles out of Center Harbor
- Eventually you will pass an Aubuchon Hardware Store on your left
- Take your next left on Saw Mill Lane and follow for 50 yards
- Take a left on Red Hill Road and follow for 1 mile
- Look for the Camp Hawkeye sign and a white barn on the left (downhill side) of the road. Pull in the parking area across the street on the right and check in at the main office in the barn.

New York: 309 miles – 5 Hours 30 minutes (according to Google Maps)

From New York you are looking at a long day’s drive.

- Leaving the city going East get on the Hutchinson River Parkway North and take to Connecticut
- In Connecticut it becomes Route 15 North; stay on 15N and follow for 64.6 miles to exit 68N-E
- Take Exit 68N-E and merge onto Route 91 North toward Hartford/Middletown/CT-66E
- Follow Route 91 N for 17.2 miles

Directions from Hartford

- Take Exit 29 and follow CT-15N/US-5N toward E Hartford/Boston/I-84 and follow for 2.1 miles
- Merge onto I-84E and follow for 40.7 miles entering into Massachusetts
- Take the exit onto 90E/Massachusetts Turnpike/Mass Pike toward Boston/NH/Maine
- Follow 90E for 27.9 miles
- Take exit 11A and Merge onto I-495 N toward NH/Maine and follow for 40 miles
- Take exit 40B and merge onto I-93 North toward Concord, NH
- Follow I-93 North for 75.1 miles
- Take exit 23 and follow “Off of the Highway (From Route 93)” directions to camp

Philadelphia: 412 miles – 7 Hours 19 minutes (according to Google Maps)

From Philadelphia you are looking at a drive as if you are “off to Grandmother’s house we go.”

- Using the Ben Franklin Bridge leave the city going East and pick up the New Jersey Turnpike
- Follow the NJTP North for 88.7 miles
- The NJTP becomes 95 North
- Continue on 95 N for another 71.3 miles through New York and into Connecticut
- Take exit 48 on the left to merge onto 91 North toward Hartford
- Follow 91 N for 36.8 miles
- Take exit 29 and follow “Directions from Hartford” from above to camp
