A typical day spent in camp begins with a 7:30am wake up. Breakfast is served, with setters from designated cabins, at 8:00, and followed by a period of cabin clean up. Campers have many responsibilities around camp as members of our special community, one of which is keeping their personal areas tidy. In addition, during clean up each camper will have a daily job helping with chores around the cabin.

Every camper begins the day in an activity with his or her individual cabin group. The second morning period, on Tuesdays and Thursdays, is cabin time, where each group plans their upcoming weekly hiking or canoeing trip. On Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays, the second morning period is a camper choice period. This schedule does not apply for days when the cabin group is on an out-of-camp trip.

The next two periods before lunchtime are another camper choice activity period followed by a second cabin group activity period. Instructional swim is a mandatory activity. It is programmed into the morning camper choice activity periods. Each camper choice period has one swimming group scheduled at the waterfront for lessons.

After lunch, there is an hour and ten minute long reading period where campers have the opportunity to write letters, read, and relax. This quiet time is followed by a third and fourth cabin activity, after which there is an all-camp free swim or field activity. Campers are given the option to swim and engage in waterfront games or become involved in games on the grassy commons. Dinner is served, again with the help of setters from each cabin, at 6:00pm.

In the evening, community activities include campfires, cabin skits, all play field activities, and creative performances. Campers return to their bunks between 8:00 and 8:45 for cabin time, until lights out depending on age.
